Deadline: Before the degree application deadline of your final semester.

Requirements

In order to obtain a minor in accounting, you must:

- Complete 18 or more credit hours of approved coursework as indicated below, of which at least 12 hours are in courses numbered 300 or higher.
- Earn a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 over the 18 credits.
- Complete ACCT 251, 252 and 301.
- The remaining 9 elective credits may be satisfied with:
 - Any 3 upper-division courses in accounting (except ACCT 490)
 - OR
 - Any 2 upper-division courses in accounting (except ACCT 490) AND substitute either BUSA 365 or BCIS 485 for 1 accounting course numbered 300 or higher.

Instructions

Application forms for an Accounting minor are due in the office of the Department of Accounting and Information Systems, Room 232, Business Complex Building the final semester you are taking classes, before the degree application deadline, for approval.

Check the "In-progress" box if the course is in progress. In-progress courses must be completed with a grade high enough to maintain the cumulative 2.0 grade point average. When the required and in-progress courses have been completed, you have met the requirements for the minor.
