



Requirements

A minor in economics consists of 18 or more credit hours of approved coursework in economics (ECON), of which at least 12 are numbered 300 or higher, all completed with a grade of “C” or higher.

Courses

Specifically required are:

- Economics 251G Principles of Macroeconomics (3 credits)
- Economics 252G Principles of Microeconomics (3 credits)
 - Economics 201G may be substituted for either Economics 251G or 252G, depending upon the approval of the Head of the Department of Economics.

Also required are:

- One course from among
 - Economics 304 Money and Banking (3 credits)
 - Economics 372 Intermediate Macroeconomic Theory (3 credits)
 - Economics 454 Business Fluctuations and Forecasting (3 credits)
- One course from among
 - Economics 401 Managerial Economics (3 credits)
 - Economics 371 Intermediate Microeconomic Theory (3 credits)

Electives:

- The remaining 6 credits may be satisfied with any upper-division courses (courses numbered 300 or higher) in economics.
