Requirements

In order to obtain a minor in information systems, you must:

- Complete 18 or more credit hours of approved coursework in IS, of which at least 12 hours are in courses numbered 300 or higher.
- Complete, as indicated below in the Examples of Courses:
 - BCIS 122 –or– CS 187
 - BCIS 222 –and–
 - BCIS 338 –or– BCIS 350.
 - The remaining 9 credits may be satisfied with any upper division BCIS courses (including ACCT 452) chosen with the consent of an IS advisor. Note that many 400-level BCIS courses have BCIS 322 as a prerequisite.
- Earn a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 over the 18 credits.

Examples of Courses

All students must complete BCIS 122 or CS 187 and BCIS 222.

Then consider following one of these two suggested patterns to complete your coursework:

- BCIS 338 with electives (9 credits):
 - ACCT 452
 - BCIS 458
 - BCIS 482
 - BCIS 485

--OR--

- BCIS 350 with electives (9 credits):
 - ACCT 452
 - BCIS 322
 - BCIS 450 (BCIS 350 is a prerequisite)
 - BCIS 455 (BCIS 322 is a prerequisite or concurrent enrollment; BCIS 350 is a prerequisite)
 - BCIS 458
 - BCIS 465 (BCIS 322 is a prerequisite or concurrent enrollment)
 - BCIS 470 (BCIS 322 is a prerequisite or concurrent enrollment; BCIS 350 is a prerequisite)
 - BCIS 475 (BCIS 350 is a prerequisite)
 - BCIS 480
 - BCIS 485
