



Requirements

The Management Minor for a **business major** requires 18 upper division credit hours in Management. The Management Minor for **non-business majors** has two possible options for requirements. The first option requires 15 upper division hours in Management and a 3-hour upper division elective in the College of Business. The second option is to take all 18 upper division credit hours in Management.

Business Majors (revised curriculum starting fall 2004): 18 credits in management.

- Any six upper division MGT or BUSA courses (BUSA 365 totals 3 MGT credits).

Non-business Majors: 18 credits in Management:

- One course from MGT 309 ~~–or–~~ or MGT 315 (not both).
- Five other upper division MGT courses (one 3-credit upper division course in the College of Business may substitute for one of the required five MGT courses).

To obtain a Management minor, a grade of "C" or better must be attained in all the courses for the minor.
