



Requirements

This minor is available to Business majors only.

A minor in Intelligence Studies consists of 18 or more credit hours of approved coursework from the following list, all completed with a grade of "C" or higher. At least 9 of the credits must be upper-division.

This minor supplements the courses in a standard business major with background courses in intelligence studies and additional skill courses; it prepares students to work for governmental intelligence agencies or private firms which work with the government on intelligence issues.

Not all of the following courses are offered by their various departments every semester. Students should check with their advisors and the specific departments to verify when these courses are being offered.

Required Courses

NOTE: Students can reduce the total credits required by carefully selecting Viewing a Wider World (VWW) courses and by using the ethics course to fill the general education requirement in thinking/analysis. Remember that at least 9 credit hours must be upper-division.

- ENGL 318G, Advanced Technical and Professional Communication (3 credits)
- PHIL 223G, Ethics (3 credits)
- ECON 490, Special Topics: Intelligence Research and Analysis (3 credits)

Electives
