



Requirements

A Minor in International Business consists of 18 or more credit hours of approved coursework in the International Business core, all completed with a grade of "C" or higher, and a language proficiency requirement.

Courses

You must complete:

- International Business 351, Introduction to International Business (3 credits)
- International Business 450, International Economics (3 credits)
- International Business 475, International Managerial Finance (3 credits)
- International Business 489, Seminar in International Business (3 credits)
- One course from among:
 - Economics 324G, Developing Nations (3 credits)
 - Economics 325G, Economic Development of Latin America (3 credits)
 - Economics 330, The Business Economy of Mexico (3 credits)
 - Honors 380, Comparative Economic Systems (3 credits)
 - International Business 398, International Business and Economic Environments (3 credits)
- One other upper-division business course (3 credits)

Required Language Proficiency

You must demonstrate oral and written proficiency in a foreign language at the intermediate mid-level according to the ACTFL (American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages) proficiency guidelines.

The process for demonstrating proficiency needs to be coordinated NMSU's Department of Languages and Linguistics. Any costs associated with proficiency demonstration will be paid by the student.
