Requirements

This minor is available to non-MBA graduate students.

MBA students can also specialize in Information Systems through the MBA Program.

In order to obtain a graduate minor in information systems (IS) you must follow the requirements as stated in the Graduate Catalog (<http://catalog.nmsu.edu/>) for a minor at the master’s level.

A minimum of 9 credits of graduate work is required.

In order for the minor to appear on your record, you must list the minor on your “Program of Study and Committee for Master’s Students” (Application for Admission to Candidacy) and have it signed by the head of the department offering the minor.

A cumulative grade point average of 3.0 in all graduate courses taken at NMSU must be earned.

Courses

You must complete:

- BCIS 540 Systems Analysis & Design.
 - Note that BCIS 540 has a prerequisite of a business programming course (either BCIS 472 or equivalent undergraduate programming course).
- BCIS 595 Database Management Systems. (Prerequisite of BCIS 540)

And one elective chosen from the following:

- BCIS 558 Knowledge Management and Decision Support.
- BCIS 480 Information/Internet Security.
- BCIS 560 Enterprise Resource Planning and Business Processes.
- BCIS 575 Management of Information Security.
