REQUIREMENTS FOR A MINOR IN ACCOUNTING

In order to obtain a minor in accounting, a student must complete 18 or more credit hours of approved course work in accounting (ACCT), of which at least 12 hours are in courses numbered 300 or higher. A cumulative grade point average of 2.0 over the 18 credits must be earned.

As indicated below, the student must complete Accounting 251, 252, and 301. The remaining 9 credits may be satisfied with any upper-division courses in accounting. BUSA 365 may be substituted for 3 credits of upper-division accounting.
