BACKGROUND KNOWLEDGE REQUIREMENTS

- 1. ACCT 2110, Principles of Accounting I (formerly ACCT 221)
- 2. ACCT 2120, Principles of Accounting II (formerly ACCT 222)
- 3. ECON 2110G, Macroeconomic Principles (formerly ECON 251G)
- 4. BFIN 341, Financial Analysis and Markets (formerly FIN 341)
- 5. MATH 1430G, Applications of Calculus I (formerly MATH 142G)
- 6. MATH 1350G, Statistics (formerly STAT 251G/ A STAT 251G) or equivalent

As an alternative to the three credit courses above, students may take one (1-cr) credit courses in the summer Boot Camp to satisfy the background knowledge/prerequisite requirements.

You must meet the courses with a grade of B or higher.

SUMMER BOOT CAMP

This intensive program is designed to get you up to speed in the background knowledge courses AND fulfills the prerequisites so that you may begin taking MBA courses in the FALL semester.

- ACCT 500 Concepts in Acct (Acct 221 and Acct 222) 1 credit hr.
- BA 500 Macroeconomics 1 credit hr.
- BA 501 Quantitative for MBA (Calculus & Statistics) 1 credit hr.
- BFIN 500 Concepts in Finance 1 credit hr.

There will be a Face-to-Face requirement over a 3-day weekend on May 13, 14, and 15 (on Zoom) followed by synchronous online meetings on TUESDAY or THURSDAY evenings throughout the summer semester ending on August 4, 2022.
